It is recommended that the applications should be completed in all aspects and submitted for admission along with the required documents. If your documents are found missing, you will be notified immediately and your application will not be reviewed until they are received. Registration Process

Step 1 – Complete the online Registration application form and Submit the documents

Candidates have to fill-in their Online application form from the below link

Step 2 – Activate your account and Pay your Registration fee

When you submit your online registration, you need to verify your account by typing your registered mobile number and get OTP after that your account will be activated and you will have to pay Rs.5500/- for application fee through Net banking/Credit card/Debit card/RTGS/Google pay/ Phone pay (non-refundable). *As per bank details, contact number and online payment link mentioned below.

Step 3 – Students login and Password

After successfully submitted the online registration fee you will receive enrollment number and Password from institute official mail – info@paramedci.com

For student login you have to enter your registered mobile number and password then you can check your student's profile.

Step 4 - Submit the Documents

Once your application form is received at admission cell, an acknowledgement will be sent to your email upon successful verification of your eligibility.

You are suggested to contact on info@paramedci.com if you do not receive any acknowledgement against your application within 3 working days from the date of your application.

Step 5- Pay your Enrollment & Examination Fees

The student selected for admission will have to pay the enrollment and examination fee and reserve his/her seat by paying a minimum of 50% of the annual fee (10000) immediately. Failing which the seat can be allotted to the other student.

Note: - Details of the fees deposited by the candidate must immediately be furnished to the Admission department through email at: info@paramedci.com giving candidate name, courses to which admitted, enrollment number and scanned copy of the Bank Receipt etc.

Step 5: Offer of Admission

However Provisional Admission Mail will be send only once the payment is confirmed from our accounts department.

Registered students are suggested to pay the balance fee immediately mentioned in their provisional admission mail within 30 days of their reservation of seat to confirm their admission. Failing which the allotted seat can be transferred to the waiting list students.

* Admissions to all programs being offered at institute will be made as per eligibility norms of Council.

Documents required for admission

- 1) 10th & 10 +2 Mark sheet & Certificate scanned copy
- 2) Passport size photograph: The dimensions of the photograph should be 3.5 x 405 cm width. Scanned photographs should be in jpg format for online submission.
- 3) A valid personal email Id and contact number.
- 4) One Id and address proof such as – Aadhar /Passport/Voter Id & Pan Card.
- 5) Any leaving /Transfer/Migration Certificate

INSTRUCTION FOR CANDIDATE -

- 1) Study material will be provided by the institution at the postal address of candidates through Indian Speed Post.
- 2) The annual examination for each year will be held in June/July and November/ December or as fixed by the Council. For failed/re- appear students supplementary examination will fixed by the Council.
- 3) Medium of examination shall be English & MCQ based.
- 4) Practical examination will be 100 marks which will divide in to two parts 50 & 50.
- 5) Students must have to earn 50 marks from practical centers (hospital and labs) and 50 marks from internal assessment of the institute.
- 6) The annual examination will be conducted by the institution in online mode, so students will appear in the online examination through their nearest cyber cafe or through their personal system etc.

- 7) Assignment questions will be provided by the institution in every session and students will have to complete their assignments and send them through registered post or courier to the institute address.
- 8) After successful completion of online diploma course students will have to join hospitals/laboratories for 6 months internship/medical practice
- 9) Hospital/ labs will be allotted according to students selected local area or choose by the institutions.
- 10) Hospitals/Lab will be allotted as per the choice of the students or chosen by the institutes. They will have to provide the names of three hospitals or laboratories near them along with their address, email id and contact numbers to the institutions for selecting the hospital/laboratories. After that the institution will contact the selected hospitals or labs by issuing letters for the medical practice of the students.
